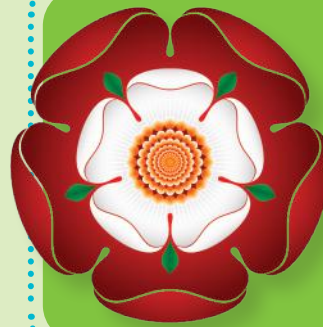




## How did the Tudors live in Greenwich?

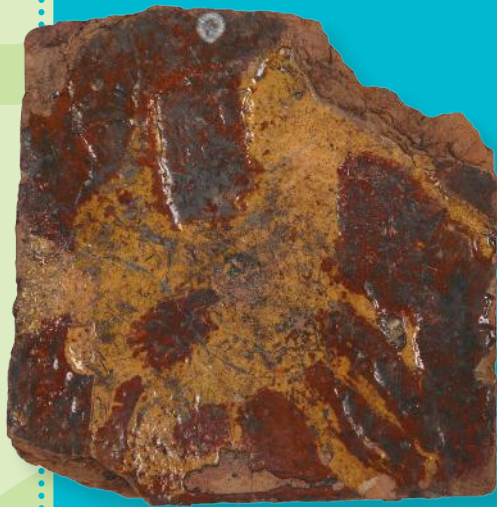

The Tudors are one of the most famous royal families in British history. The Tudor period began on 22 August 1485 and lasted until 24 March 1603. There were six Tudors monarchs in total: **Henry VII**, **Henry VIII**, **Edward VI**, **Lady Jane Grey**, **Mary I** and **Elizabeth I**.



This rose is the symbol of the House of Tudor, that became the symbol of England.

Rich and poor lived very different lives in Tudor times. Rich people had opulent lives, with grand houses, expensive clothes and rich diets. The poor had to work hard, could not read or write, had little access to food and lived in small and flimsy houses.



This tile comes from the famous Tudor Palace of Placentia in Greenwich (picture below). Henry VIII, Mary I and Elizabeth I were born here. It was demolished by Charles II.
